Endesa has taken part in the Transmission and Distribution (T&D) Europe 2008 Conference. The objective of the conference was to improve service to the end-user client through the safety, quality, sustainability and profitability aspects of energy supply. The event, which took place in Amsterdam, Holland, was attended by over 400 high-level participants from more than 26 countries.

The Organising Committee consisted of senior executives with extensive experience in the sector, including Josep Ballart, Endesa Red's Director of Operations, Analysis and Systems.

This year there has been a special emphasis on Smart Grids and also on the analyses of the impact that the 3rd package of regulatory changes are having on the business in Europe. In the area of the future evolution of Technical Systems in electrical companies, Sandra Alfonso, Assistant Director of Endesa's ICT Infrastructure Projects, gave a talk on the need to maintain operational control over critical telecommunications structures, emphasising the importance of tele-management projects as vital elements in Smart Grids.

Other presentations covered sustainability and the distribution of renewable energy, regulatory changes and the financing and ownership of transmission and distribution networks.
